

Mahoney Makes Ft. Pierce Courthouse a Reality

Awards Contract to New Developer to Build Courthouse

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“I am so proud of the productive partnership between my office, Senator Bill Nelson, the General Services Administration, and our local elected officials. Without our collective efforts, the dream of this courthouse would not be a reality,” said Congressman Mahoney. “The Courthouse is critical for getting St. Lucie’s economy back on track.”

Construction of the Ft. Pierce Courthouse was originally supposed to begin in November 2007, but was delayed due to a lack of competitive bids and cost escalations. Following a meeting in April 2008, GSA committed to releasing a new bid in June and making an award in September. The GSA also committed to working with Congressman Mahoney and Ft. Pierce local elected officials to expand their outreach effort, particularly to potential subcontractors.

The contract award is for \$41,957,595 and construction is expected to begin at the end of October.
